The Fun Meet will be run along the same guidelines for USA Gymnastics Competition. Each gymnast will perform a routine on four (4) Olympic Gymnastic Events. Routines will be judged and receive a score. As this is a **FUN** meet, scores will neither be flashed nor posted. At the conclusion of competition, each gymnast will receive a certificate listing his/her scores for each event. **MINI OLYMPIANS WILL NOT BE JUDGED AND WILL NOT RECEIVE SCORES.** The routines performed will be appropriate to the gymnast's skill level. Coaches will be on hand at each event to assist verbally or with physical spotting.

**AWARDS** Mini Olympians will each receive a participation certificate and trophy. All other levels will receive a participation certificate, an achievement ribbon for each event, and trophy for all-around.

**IMPORTANT: GYMNASTS MUST PARTICIPATE IN MEET TO RECEIVE AWARDS.**

Trophies cannot be awarded to gymnasts that do not participate in the meet. Awards are earned through participation. Gymnasts that are entered in the meet but are unable to participate, will receive T-shirt, and other misc. goodies but no awards (trophies, ribbons or certificates).

**GIRLS ATTIRE:** Competition appropriate attire is a 1-piece leotard (just the body suit) without belts, ruffles, or skirts, No pants or tights on the legs. No jewelry – with the exception of small post earrings. Hair should be pulled back securely, including long bangs, so that no hair is in or near eyes or falling into face. Pony tails, pigtails, buns or french braids are excellent.

**PRETEAM & RAVEN – APPROPRIATE ATTIRE** is the Black Bright Raven Team Tank with “Bright Raven” embroidered in gold on front chest and Bright Raven logo on back. If you do not own this leotard, please place order by MAY 5<sup>TH</sup>.

**BOYS** wear gym shorts which are loose enough for comfortable movement but avoid bagginess, along with **tucked-in** T-shirt. No jewelry. Shorts with zippers, belts, snaps or buckles are not appropriate.

**SPECTATORS:** Spectators are encouraged to applaud each performance. All spectators must remain in the areas designated for spectators. Under no circumstances may parents, siblings, friends, etc. approach the competition area.

**ADMISSION:** Spectators will be asked for a small donation to support Bright Raven upon entering the gym. Suggested donation: \$2/adult, \$1/child.

**FLASH PICTURES ARE NOT PERMITTED DURING THE MEET.**

You may use a video camera or still camera **without flash** during competition, or you may pose your child after the meet is over, if your camera uses a flash. Use of flash during competition could startle a gymnast causing a fall or injury.
